## WEEK 3

**SUNDAY, AUGUST 29**

## **SURRENDER TO THE HOLY SPIRIT BELIEVING FOR SIGNS, WONDERS & THE SUPERNATURAL**

### **SCRIPTURE**

**JOHN 14:25 NIV** “All this I have spoken while still with you. But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.”

**ROMANS 8:11 NLT** “The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead, he will give life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you.”

### **OBSERVATION**

When we say “yes” to God, He doesn’t just transform us from the inside out, He also equips us with the Holy Spirit, our advocate and guide. When we are surrendered to the Holy Spirit, God does some of His greatest work in our hearts and minds. The Holy Spirit comforts and guides us in our valley seasons and when we’re on life’s mountaintops, He rejoices with us and leads us with wisdom so that we can be and do all that we’ve been called to do for the glory of God.

### **APPLICATION**

When’s the last time you contemplated the power of the Holy Spirit in your life? Take a moment today to thank God for empowering you with the gift of the Holy Spirit. If you’re not sure how the Holy Spirit is active in your life, pray that God would reveal to you His power through the work of the Holy Spirit in this season of your life.

### **PRAYER**

Heavenly Father, I thank you that the same spirit who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in me. I thank you that you send the Holy Spirit as a comforter and advocate for every season of my life. I pray that you would open my eyes to see the miraculous in a world that is desperately in need of renewal and hope. And, Lord, if there be any unbelief or waywardness in my heart, help me with my unbelief and lead me in the way I should go. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

## MONDAY, AUGUST 30

### MOVE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT FOR SALVATIONS

#### SCRIPTURE

**TITUS 3:5 NLT** “When God our Savior revealed his kindness and love, he saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth and new life through the Holy Spirit. He generously poured out the Spirit upon us through Jesus Christ our Savior.”

**HEBREWS 11:6 NLT** “And it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to him must believe that God exists and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him.”

#### OBSERVATION

When we make the decision to give Jesus lordship over our lives, we encounter a new life through the work of the Holy Spirit in us. It is both instantaneous and an ongoing process; this new life requires faith in Jesus’ finished work on the cross. The amazing thing about our God is that He can do so much with just a little bit of faith.

#### APPLICATION

Think about a few people today who need to experience the new life that Titus 3 talks about. Write down 3 names of people that you are praying for. After you write those names down, take a few minutes to pray for each one.

#### PRAYER

Holy Spirit, I believe that you are working in the lives of those whom you have put on my heart. I pray that my friends and family would have an encounter with you, especially those who don’t yet know you. I thank you that it is your kindness and love that brings us to repentance. I pray that you would shower your love on those who need you. I thank you for the new life I experienced when I received you as my savior and pray for those in my life who haven’t yet. I pray that you would generously pour out your Holy Spirit that many would experience your love. In the name of Jesus, Amen.



**TUESDAY, AUGUST 31**

## **MOVE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT ON OUR CHURCH & TEAM**

### **SCRIPTURE**

**ACTS 2:1-4 TPT** “On the day Pentecost was being fulfilled, all the disciples were gathered in one place. Suddenly they heard the sound of a violent blast of wind rushing into the house from out of the heavenly realm. The roar of the wind was so overpowering it was all anyone could bear! Then all at once a pillar of fire appeared before their eyes. It separated into tongues of fire that engulfed each one of them. They were all filled and equipped with the Holy Spirit and were inspired to speak in tongues—empowered by the Spirit to speak in languages they had never learned!”

**ROMANS 12:5 TPT** “And so it is in the body of Christ. For though we are many, we’ve all been mingled into one body in Christ. This means that we are all vitally joined to one another, with each contributing to the others.”

### **OBSERVATION**

In Acts we read “they were all filled and equipped with the Holy Spirit,” this is the fulfillment of an Old Testament promise God gave his people. This fulfillment brought with it a call to action: To live a life of purity, sanctity, full surrender to God, and to fervently share the message of Jesus throughout the world. The Holy Spirit is a gift from God to equip the church to share this message of salvation, through Jesus, to the world around us. The book of Romans highlights that we’re each created differently to form part of God’s body here on earth, each designed to fulfill the calling He has for us. We can trust that we are each equipped to run our race while being vitally joined to one another.

### **APPLICATION**

The purpose of the move of the Holy Spirit in the Church and among our teams, is to come into alignment to the direction of Christ. The Holy Spirit can transform our atmosphere, and convict all who hear while bearing witness to the authority and presence of Jesus. Today, take some time to ask the Holy Spirit to speak to you and through you.

### **PRAYER**

Lord, I thank you for who you are. Thank you for sending your Spirit to awaken and transform me. Open my eyes, and my ears to hear what your Spirit is saying to me, and to my church. I pray that you would send a fresh wind, a fresh fire over our church, and over each team. I pray that through your Spirit we would move in one accord, and that your Lordship, the reality of who you are, would transcend over every gathering. Holy Spirit, cover Citizen Heights and my team (pray over your team by name). Forgive me for my offenses, and bring me closer to you. You are welcome here. I pray for all those who will come to know you, may your Salvation reign in this place. In Jesus’ name, I pray. Amen.



**WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 1**

## **MOVE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IN OUR HOMES**

### **SCRIPTURE**

**2 CORINTHIANS 3:17 NIV** “Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.”

**ROMANS 15:13 NIV** “May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.”

### **OBSERVATION**

When it comes to a move of the Holy Spirit, our homes are often ground zero—the center or origin of change. The change that happens in our homes, through the work of the Holy Spirit, can cause a ripple effect through our social and professional networks. At times, just seeing the joy and peace that someone has found in Jesus can serve as the catalyst for change in a close friend’s life or even in a colleague’s life. When the Holy Spirit is moving in our homes, everything and everyone else can be transformed for the better.

### **APPLICATION**

Ask God, in prayer, to initiate a move of the Holy Spirit in your home and in your mind. When He answers, believe Him.

### **PRAYER**

Heavenly Father, I believe that you can move in my home and in the hearts and minds of my family members. I thank you that where Your Spirit is, there is freedom. I thank you that you are able and willing to fill me up to overflow with joy and peace as I choose to trust in you. May your Holy Spirit dwell in every corner of my home and change the atmosphere with each passing day. Thank you for allowing us to experience the power of the Holy Spirit no matter the circumstances or challenges we’re navigating. I pray that my home would be an instrument of your peace. In Jesus’ name. Amen.

**THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 2**

## **MOVE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IN OUR PERSONAL WORLD**

### **SCRIPTURE**

**GALATIANS 5:22-25 NLT** “But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. There is no law against these things! Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed the passions and desires of their sinful nature to his cross and crucified them there. Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit’s leading in every part of our lives.”

**PSALM 1:2-3 NLT** “But they delight in the law of the Lord, meditating on it day and night. They are like trees planted along the riverbank, bearing fruit each season. Their leaves never wither, and they prosper in all they do.”

### **OBSERVATION**

When we allow the Holy Spirit to move in our lives, there is obvious fruit as a result. The fruit of the Holy Spirit listed in Galatians 5 is attainable for us as believers, as long as our hearts are open and surrendered to the work of the Holy Spirit in us. Each trait listed in Galatians 5 is every believer’s heritage and is a natural result of our living “by the Spirit” through faith in Christ. Our entire world changes when we humble ourselves, and allow love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control to be written into our spiritual DNA.

### **APPLICATION**

Take a moment today to quiet your mind and meditate on these passages. Think about which fruit(s) of the spirit you’d most like to see increase in your life. Then, take time to ask God to help you live more by the leading of the Holy Spirit each day.

### **PRAYER**

Father God, I thank you for the Holy Spirit at work in my life. I pray that you would help me to humble myself and follow your lead. Let my life be one that abounds with the fruit of the Holy Spirit, that your work in me would be undeniable. I thank you that as I follow you, and fruit is produced, that the lives of those around me will be blessed. I thank you for the personal work of the Holy Spirit within me. Help me to be a light that shines in every area, producing fruit in every season. I pray these things in Jesus’ name, Amen.

**FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 3**

## **MOVE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT ON OUR PASTORS & LEADERS**

### **SCRIPTURE**

**ACTS 4:31 TPT** “As they prayed the earth shook beneath them, causing the building they were in to tremble. Each one of them was filled with the Holy Spirit, and they proclaimed the word of God with unrestrained boldness.”

**ACTS 8:14-17 TPT** “When the apostles in Jerusalem heard that the Samaritans had accepted God’s message of life, they sent Peter and John to pray over them so that they would receive the Holy Spirit. For they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus and were yet to have the Holy Spirit fall upon them. As soon as Peter and John arrived, they laid their hands on the Samaritan believers, one after another, and the Holy Spirit fell and filled each one of them!”

### **OBSERVATION**

The work of the Holy Spirit brings boldness to proclaim, and speak the truth of God with authority and confidence in the face of opposition. The presence of the Holy Spirit creates a dependency on scripture, the living word of God. The presence of the Holy Spirit leads to a focus on Christ and the gospel. We can, therefore, believe God to pour His Spirit out on our pastors and leaders as they lead and serve our community. We can entrust their lives into His hands as He prunes and strengthens each of them.

### **APPLICATION**

If you haven’t done so already, or if it’s been a while, consider reading the book of Acts to learn more about how the Holy Spirit moved in the life of the early church. You’ll learn or be reminded of how important it is that we see a move of the Holy Spirit in our leaders, our pastors, and our church today. Today, take time to pray for our pastors and leaders, thanking the Holy Spirit for the work he started and will finish in them.

### **PRAYER**

Heavenly Father, thank you for my pastors, and leaders. Thank you that your Holy Spirit is with them, strengthening them, anointing them, and giving them a fresh word, and vision for this season. I pray that you would pour your Spirit anew on each of them. Strengthen them, and guide them as they lead us, your church. I pray for my leaders, that your Holy Spirit would guide them to make the right choices, to speak your word with authority and truth. Thank you Holy Spirit for the work you have already started in them. I declare that we will witness a fresh move of your Spirit and that more lives will come to know Jesus’ saving grace. In Jesus’ name I pray, Amen.

### **APPLICATION**


### **PRAYER**
